## Part of the 2016 HOPE Conference pre-programme

LeHo is an EU three-year project funded by the EACEA (Education And Culture European Agency). It focuses on the potential of using various technologies in the complex field of Home and Hospital Education (HHE), on an international basis and under a specific pedagogical framework.

As most of you already know, HOPE is part of the international network of LeHo, and these paths crossed at the Bucharest Congress of 2014, when the HOPE CM met the LeHo experts and members.

For the Vienna congress, LeHo will be facing its final and most important phase. One of the main products of LeHo is a set of Training Actions to be delivered to Hospital and Home Teachers on how to improve their use of ICT with children with a medical condition.
